History of the Darlington Covered Bridge.

As the land north and west of Darlington became thickly populated there was in need of a bridge over Sugar Creek. Farmers wanted to reach local markets and the grist mill located close by regardless of the weather or high water. This led to the movement to build a covered bridge just west of the old mill. At the present time Samuel Martz, was a member of the Board of County Commissioners, the other two members were Taylor Buffington, and David Long. John Manker and John E. Corbin were the ones that carried the petition for the bridge erection. On the petition were the names of the following: William Cox, Enoch Peacock, William Milner, Jacob Deans, William Griest, Guard Booher, Henry Huffman, Thomas & William Wheeler, John B. Lowman, Zieba Thomas, and many others. These names which figured prominently in the early history of the community. Donation towards the project totalling \$ 1,585. were made by the people of the community and on April 15, 1866 these donations were received by the Board of County Commissioners. The Board then appropriated the additional funds needed, and the present site was selected June 13, 1866. The Board the proceeding March directed that a practical bridge builder be engaged. Ricard Epperson was appointed superintendent of the construction. The contract was awarded to Joseph Kress. The bridge was completed in 1868. Each year several people travel many a mile to view the old mill and bridge. Artist spends hours sitting on the banks of Sugar Creek, making sketches of these landmarks which become more and more romantic with the passing of each year. This is usual too because they are close enough together to be placed on a single canvas. Cora Moore Peele, a former resident of Darlington, now of Whittier California, etched the likeness of the mill on a wooden plaque, and sent it back to her home town to be hung in the Public Library where it may be seen today.
