Lee Allen moved Carl Watts second that the President appoint a committee of two to hire a janitor for the coming season. The motion was adopted and Mr. Allen and Mr. Watts were appointed on this committee. There being no further business the meeting was adjourned by motion.

Upon above date after due notice the stockholders of Oakland Cemetery Association held their biannual meeting at the M & B Church in Elmdale for the purpose of electing a board of Directors for the coming two years

The President Lester Blinn after explaining fully the object of the meeting proceeded to act as Chairman and before any names were placed in nomination Ray & Dayey made a motion which was supported unanimously that the present board which consisted of B F Fulwider J Lee Allen and Virgil Merritt be reelected to serve another term of two years

In the absence of Mr Fulwider J Lee Allen and Virgil Merritt organized the board by selecting Lester Blinn president Carl Watter vice president T & Bunnell sec. and Treasure for another term of two years

The President upon suggestion of the treasure appointed Ray & Dayey and J Lee Allen to audit the books of the Association and also render assistance upon disposition of notes held by Association
The meeting was adjourned by motion

April 29 1937

The members of the Oakland Cemetery Association were called to meet at the Home of the President Lester Olin for the transaction of such business as should come before them.

After some discussion as to the needs of the Cemetery a Motion was made by B F Fulwider and seconded by Ray Hazey that the President appoint a Committee to collect the outstanding notes. This motion was passed and the President appointed Lee Alden, Ray Hazey and T E Bunnell on this committee.

They ^{were} authorized if it was necessary to omit the interest in order to collect to do so.

It was also decided to erect a new fence on the South and East sides of the Cemetery.

The President volunteered to see that the old fence was removed and the new one built.

B F Fulwider, Virgil Merritt and Carl Watts were appointed to hire a caretaker for the year. There being no further business the meeting was adjourned by Motion.

April 24th 1940

Upon the above date the Officers and directors of the Oakland Cemetery Association met at the home of the President Lester Olin to transact such business as regulary came before them.

After some discussion as to the needs of the Cemetery Lester Olin volunteered to see the attorney as to the possibility of procuring some funds to help to care for same.

Virgil Merritt moved and Ray Hazey seconded a motion to the effect that all notes that are not paid by June 1-40 shall be collected with interest. This motion was supported by all. As the funds of the Cemetery available for use seemed small T E Bunnell moved Carl Watts second that the Lots be advanced from \$15⁰⁰ (Fifteen dollars) to \$25⁰⁰ (Twenty five) effective after July 1-1940. This motion was also supported by all.

The President appointed Ray Hazey and Virgil Merritt to hire a painter for the coming year.

The Secretary was instructed to post notices for Election of Directors June 3-1940.

A motion to adjourn by T E Bunnell was carried.

The president appointed Virgil Merritt and Ray Gazez as a committee to hire some one

Virgil Merritt moved Ray Gazez second a motion to increase the pay to 50¢ per hour which was carried

Mr Merritt volunteered to see the county road man with regard to repairing the west approach to the Cemetery

The Board approved the action of the treasurer in accepting a note from Lawrence Maxwell for \$22⁵⁰ for burial space in the Old part of the Cemetery

Notices having already been posted for the coming Stakeholders meeting June 1 - 42 a motion to adjourn was carried

The President appointed Ray Dazey and Chester Hutellison to hire a janitor for the coming year. There being no farther business the motion to adjourn was supported

The president appointed Ray Baze and William McClure to proceed with changing the driveway all ready ordered.

On June 10th the officers of the Oakland Cemetery Association were called together at the home of Sister Olin president. Ray Dagg and Bob Fulwider - trustees, John Walls and Sister Olin pres. were present.

The report of the last meeting and the financial report was read.

Herbert Irwin was hired to mow the cemetery.

Willie Pearson was to dig the graves for the coming year.

After much discussion on ways to improve the cemetery, it was decided to encourage the people to provide a new shelter house.

Sister Olin advised we elect our directors according to the provisions of the law instead of the way we had done in the past.

The Oakland Cemetery Assn. held their meeting at Center Methodist Church on June 4, 1956.

Lester Olin called meeting to order and asked for the Sec. and Treas. report. These were read and approved.

After some discussion the Pres. asked that the people consider building a cement block house in place of the old shelter house. It was suggested the building should have facilities for heating.

The Pres. asked what could be done to improve the Assn. Some of the members expressed a desire for a little more care to be taken in handling the excess dirt.

Nominations were asked for trustees. Mrs. Wath nominating Ray Dayey, Paul Lane being nominated by Mrs. Dayey and Mrs. Olin nominating Hubert Irwin. It was moved now to be closed and the motion carried.

On motion by Ida McClure the Sec. was instructed to cast entire vote for the trustees.

After the meeting was adjourned the trustees appointed the following officers

Sister Olin called the meeting to order and asked for the Sec. and Treas. report. These reports were read and approved.

A review of the past receipts showed we had been spending more than we had been receiving.

Mrs. Hutchinson suggested we assess the property owners for what money we needed.

Some members seemed to think we might be paying too much for mowing.

There was a great deal of discussion on the building project and replenishing our bank account.

Pres. Olin asked that the by-laws be read about the assessing the property owners.

Vivigt made a motion to assess the lot owners 5 dollars and Ray second the motion. All entered in discussing their motions.

When a vote was asked most every one was in favor and the motion carried.

Next they talked of the building project. The Pres. stated that neither he nor the trustees wanted all the responsibility and asked permission to appoint a building com.

Mr. Olin app. Wilbur Humphrey - John Bunnell and Ray Dagey.

The Pres. instructed the Sec. to notify all the property owners of the assessment.

He also asked if there was any other business to consider. Ray suggested we get a load of stone for the device to be placed at the corner.

With no other business to consider the meeting was adjourned.

The officers of the Cemetery Ass. were called together at the home of Ray Dazey. Paul, Foster and John were present.

All reviewed the treasure report. The book showed the donations far exceeded the expense of the building. Also the assessments had come in at a good rate.

We decided we would make a special effort to remove the excess dirt.

Ray stated most cemeteries were paying 35 dollars and more for opening graves and that Sherman felt he should get more for digging. The Pres. said it was the trustees' duties to take what ever action they felt best. Ray and Paul said they would contact Hubert before taking any definite action.

The Oakland Cemetery Ass. held their annual meeting at Center Church on June 2, 1958.

Leslie Olin called meeting to order and asked for the Sec. & Treas. Report. These were read and approved.

After some discussion, the Pres. suggested we encourage people to buy lots. He also asked if any one had any matters to bring up about the cemetery. The Pres. stated we had given the dirt away several times but it still remained a problem.

Mr. Olin said we should give John Bunnell a vote of thanks for his labor on the building.

Mrs. Huthinsin cautioned us to not mow the grounds off too early. It was suggested all might clean up and care for their flowers and make a much neater cemetery.

Ray said John Bunnell had a bill on constituting the cleaning. Pres. suggested the minutes under the bill paid.

Pres. asked for any other business besides cleaning directors. He asked for nominations. Seland said every thing was running smoothly and made motion to re-elect the same directors. Wilbur Humphreys second the motion. A vote was asked and the motion carried.

After meeting was adjourned the directors had a discussion in the sidewalk and appointed the present officers to serve again.

The Oakland Cemetery Ass. held their annual meeting at Center Church on June 2, 1959

Pres. opened meeting by calling for the Sec. and Treas. report. These were read and approved.

The Treas. stated that he had been charging the account for bank services and check charges and asked permission to credit our account for these services charged and not used. Permission was granted.

Pres. asked if there was any business. Mrs. Miller suggested repairing the North entrance.

Ray stated Bob Fulwider might use road equipment for the job. Nearly all content in discussing the question.

Paul Lane made motion and second by Seland for the Pres. to appoint some one to see if it could be repaired satisfactorily without costing too much. Ray was to over see the work.

Ray suggested straightening some of the markers. All agreed something should be done.

John Bunnell said the floor on outside of building needed more support and he would do what was necessary.

Paul Lane stated Mrs. Hutchison's requested him to bring up at our meeting the cemetery needed something better to manage the dirt at grave side. Pres. asked Paul to see if it.

Pres. asked if there was anything more to consider stating we had had a worth while meeting and thanked all for coming. Thirteen were present. Meeting was then adjourned.

The Oakland Cemetery Assn. had their annual meeting June 6-1960. Sec. report was read and approved.

Pres. opened meeting by stating according to the by-laws this was the year for election of officers. He said this should be the first order of business and acted for nominations.

Mrs. Grace Meritt made motion to keep the present directors. This motion was seconded and Selma Olin nominated Eugene Meritt to replace the vacancy left by Paul Sauer's death. Sydney Langworthy made motion now be done - being seconded by Selma.

Then motion carried. Percy Dazy - Eugene Meritt and Hubert Jovin are to be directors for the next two years. The Pres. instructed them to appoint the necessary officers of the association.

The treas. report was read and the Pres. explained about the material bond and all deposited the investment in the savings account.

Mrs. Olin said the gateway needed repairing. There was a lot of discussion on this problem and several suggestions were made. Pres. appointed the directors to attempt to solve the problem of the gateway and arch.

Selma mentioned the cemetery looked real nice Memorial day. Many others agreed the same.

Question was raised about the by-laws of the Assn. and the Sec. read them to the members present.

The newly appointed directors asked present officers to ~~remain~~ remain and all said they would.

Questions arose about bonding the Treas. Ray saying he should be according to the corporation's Pres. instructed the directors to say when and how much and the Treas. should be bonded and the place to get the bond.

No other business the meeting was adjourned.
 Fourteen present.

The Oakland Cemetery Assoc. had their annual meeting June 5-1961

Pres. called meeting to order and asked for the Sec. and Treas. Report. These were read and approved.

The Sec. informed the attendees the Soc. fund had matured and Pres. asked if there was any objection to putting the fund money in savings. After some discussion Lester stating the Trustees make a final decision and instruct the Treas.

Pres. asked for any other business. Mrs. Olin saying the flowers had been cut off too early and suggested more can be taken in mowing.

Pres. asked for any suggestions or improving our cemetery. Mrs. Humphreys said ditch holes in road need repairing.

Trustees were asked on "Orders of Officers" and the by-laws were read with the year 1962 being year for election.

No further business, motion was made and carried the meeting be adjourned.

There were 15 present which included all officers and trustees.
